Gender Inclusive Housing Agreement

- All students requesting space must mutually request each other and Gender Inclusive Housing.
- All students requesting Gender Inclusive Housing must be considered upper-class students at the time of move-in.
- A group of mutual roommate requests must fill the living unit/apartment and leave no open spaces. If a group of students requesting gender inclusive housing are unable to fill living unit/apartment, the request for Gender Inclusive Housing will be denied and students will reside in “traditional” single gender housing.
- If a requested roommate leaves University Housing or space prior to the end of the Housing contract, the remaining roommates will have a limited timeframe to find a replacement roommate. The timeframe will be determined by the Associate Director of Housing –Operations. If a replacement roommate is not found within the designated timeframe, all remaining roommates will be moved to “traditional” single gender housing as determined by space availability.
- University Housing reserves the right to reassign students residing in the Gender Inclusive space due to failure to adjust to living in Gender Inclusive Housing and/or due to conduct issues.
- It will be the responsibility of the requesting students to respond to any concerns raised by their parent(s) or guardian(s) regarding their choice to live in Gender Inclusive Housing.
