Your Learning Resource Center now has access to 75,000+ ebooks and audiobooks through Illinois Heartland Library System's cloudLibrary!

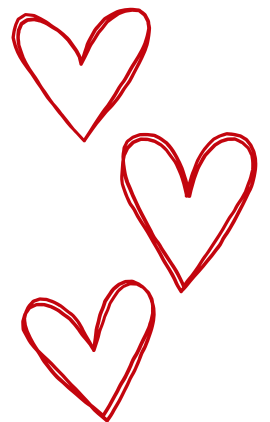
All you need is a library card with us and to set up a pin to log-in and start reading!

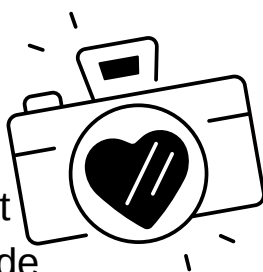

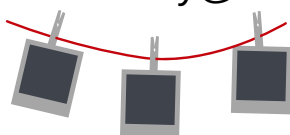


EAST ST. LOUIS THROUGH YOUR EYES
