Virtual Crafty Friday

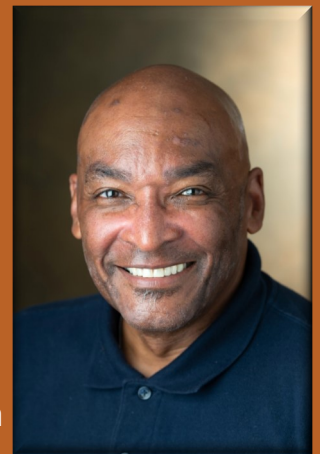
